Liebe Freunde, Unterstützer und Interessierte der Burmahilfe,

auf den Tag genau vor 2 Jahren am 1. Februar 2021 stürzte das Militär in Myanmar die frei gewählte Regierung und übernahm auf brutale Art und Weise über Nacht erneut die Macht. Seither herrscht nach einer kurzen Zeit der Hoffnung und ersten Schritten in eine demokratische Gesellschaft für die Menschen erneut ein unmenschliches Regime in Myanmar, welches in den vergangenen 2 Jahren an die 3.000 Menschen umgebracht und rund 14.000 Menschen eingesperrt hat und seither täglich Kämpfe aus der Luft und am Boden gegen das eigene Volk führt.

Unsere Unterstützung für die Menschen in dem Land hat sich seither gewandelt – an eine kontinuierliche Fortsetzung der vielversprechend begonnenen und verwirklichten Projekte ist in dieser Situation mehr zu denken, zumal manches davon auch der sinnlosen Zerstörungswut des Militärs zum Opfer fiel.

Dennoch geht unsere Hilfe weiter, wir sind im regelmäßigen Kontakt mit unseren Partnern vor Ort und möchten aus aktuellem Anlass den vor ein paar Tagen erst erhaltenen Bericht aus dem von uns unterstützten Dorf direkt und ungetkürzt an euch weiterschicken.

Education Report in Tha Bye Aye village

All schools closed in the country nearly three years because of covid-19 and military coup from 2019 to 2021. Now schools are running again in Sagaing region and some parts of the country since 2022 including Tha Bye Aye village school where is running with 25 volunteer teachers who are supported 50,000 kyats each month as salary. We have 7 months already provided (8,750,000) kyats around (4000) Euro and provided other required educational tools. The donation came from Burmahilfe Leipzig (e.V) from Germany. More than 100 schools are running under guideline of National Unity Government (NUG) in Yinmabin Township. We are running right now for this school year 2023. We will appreciate if Burmahilfe Leipzig (e.V) could help for the volunteer teachers also this year. Thank you so much indeed for the donation without your help we cannot run our school and the children could lead wrong direction. Nelson Mandela, south African leader said that if not it's citizens are educated no country can really develop. Education is the light of hope for the citizens of Burma where people are living in the darkness of military brutal regime. We won't give up until we reach our aim which is the freedom of people. As Mother Teresa said that alone we can do little but many we can do a lot. With the power of help from Germany we feel enough strength and we will go on to become our dream real to educate children.
